



The seventh grade at Sacred Heart School is part of a middle school curriculum in which the students rotate to different classes throughout the day. Mrs. Martel is the seventh grade homeroom teacher and she teaches science, Spanish, and vocabulary to all of the middle school students. She also teaches seventh grade religion. Sixth grade teacher Mr. Furtado teaches middle school math and social studies. The eighth grade teacher, Mrs. Clupny teaches language arts and literature to all middle school grades.

The seventh graders, along with grades six and eight, all participate in the Sacred Heart science fair. The science fair takes place during the second trimester and school winners participate in the Rhode Island Science and Engineering Fair (RISEF). We have had great success at the state fair. At the 2012 RISEF, Sacred Heart had four students achieve Best In Fair status.

In Spanish class students learn the vocabulary of everyday objects as well as greetings, seasons, etc. They learn to write basic sentences and read passages. We enjoy performing skits in Spanish for other classes.

Many of our seventh graders participate in the school band and chorus, performing at various venues in Rhode Island and Massachusetts.
